Sunday Morning

Albion.

I am so much distressed
dreadfully but I will write you
a little to you notwithstanding
I received your letter this morn'g
right yesterday I felt really sorry
for Auger's disappointment and of
course thought it was from Canisot
the letter was handed to me last

and as Angie was channing I offered
to open it for her and instead of
a letter for her inside there was
one for me. I am really very sorry
that you are not coming down to
Charley Grove tomorrow but duty before
pleasure. This time I shall not go
away from home tomorrow to find
the church but shall stay at home
and think and dream of you if
I cannot be with you.

Jane was much gratified with your
note to her and will expect her
thanks when she sees you again.
You know that I am always
happy to have you come here and
therefore you will be expected on
Saturday. I lost or left my camera
film at New Beckwith's, when it is
convenient will you please make
inquiries there for it. It was done up

in place of paper the last I saw of
it.

Father is ready
to go to Kingsville and I will not
write any more at present but
let him take this to the office.

accept much love from
Emma
