Enclosed you will find a letter from Albion reced Thursday last, I sent answer next morning, I think the object of removing them from Atlanta is to exchange them from that point. but I have no sources of information except those open to the public but I can hopefull and look for the best. I have seen your note. There is a bundle of letters in one of his trunks maybe yours I will comply with your wishes if I should not be at home before long if he is exchanged I think he would be here before joining his Regiment.

His letter came unsealed I
sent enclosed in envelope in the
same manner, you will see
at once the propriety of being
guarded in what you write
A word of New news would
stop the whole thing at once
