My Wife -

Another letter from
you today. Bless you for a darling
as you are - All soon come right
You are "just the woman for an
soldier's wife" - I have just time
for a little scribble to you tonight -
I am going on duty as Judge Advo-
cate of a Gen - Court Martial - to which
I am sent may be there for several
weeks - While thus occupied I shall
have to write almost incessantly - (you
see I am practising for it now) and
shall be too tired to write letters to you
must be patient and think that in-
stead of writing to you, your husband
is making out the record of some poor
fellow who is condemned to be shot to death

with immediacy" - I don't have
any trouble about Mrs Foster's
my debt. - The simple fact is this -
I made an arrangement with Cron to
pay that and supposed he had done so
a year ago or more - but he
forgot it or has been short of money
which was true - I would rather
pay it five times than have him
trouble with it now - He has enough
on his hands as a letter said - but
might embarrass me - When I am paid
I shall write to Mrs F - explaining
the matter and paying her the amount
claimed - She need not have made
so much ado about it but acted
like a woman - As to Kitch - if I
knew he had said no I would
send "Cham" to flay him. I suppose
Gargie thought that merely a confirma-
tion of the conclusion she had arri-
ved at - viz - that I ^{am} not worthy
of trust or confidence - Paul.

to do - I have not time tonight
to advise you - Tell Foster all
about it and see what he says -
He may have some bright idea that
will ~~do~~ do all our plans -
Rowell will go home in a
few days and I shall send by him an
Autotype which I had taken at
Decherd and which you can send to
Buttavia or anywhere you choose &
have photos taken from it - It is
not so good as I would wish but the
best I could get - When you have the photos
taken direct them to be sent - I
guess you will get some thing new -
