Aug. 13th 1168 -

My Dear Wife:

It is now about time for sober
honest folk to be in bed where I intend soon to deposit
my weary self very soon. My clerk - Corp. Fitch - of
A.C. 105th - is now putting affairs to rights in
the room and we shall soon be ready to leave.

I have been very busy all this week on the trial of
some 10 or 12 rogues who have been brought before
the Court. I write from 12 to 25 or 30 pages of evidence
every day and have to conduct the trial besides.

Your letter of some forgotten date was
received tonight. I don't know whether that or
my cuppa was slighted, - but I do know that
both kept me from my work but a very short
time. You see I have not been to see the "widow"
yet. I shall go just as soon as I can however.
