INTERNAL REVENUE LICENSE.



TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This License is granted to A. W. Dwyer of the Town of Conneaut in the County of Ashtabula and State of Ohio, to carry on the business or occupation of Lawyer at No. his Office, Cleveland Block Street, in the aforementioned place, he having paid the tax of \$2 Dollars therefor, conformably to the provisions of an Act entitled "An Act to provide Internal Revenue to support the Government, and to pay interest on the public debt," approved July 1, 1862, and the amendments and supplements thereto.

This License to be in force until the first day of May, 1865, provided the holder thereof shall conform to the requirements of said Act, and of such other Act or Acts as are now or may hereafter be in this behalf enacted.
