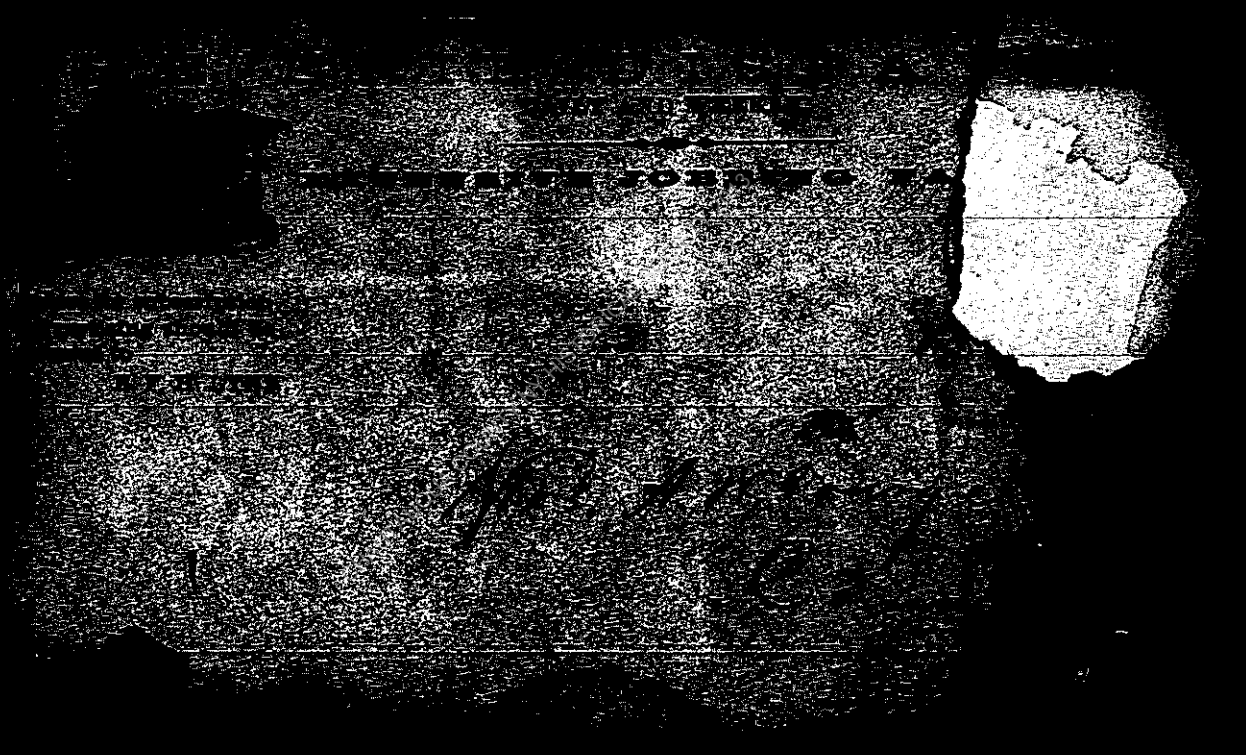
Dear Wife:
