If you have been accountable for any articles of Clothing or Equipage, all Returns due must be transmitted to this office, accompanied by an affidavit of Form No. 2.

No Returns appear to have been received from you. Blank forms Nos 1 & 2 are enclosed. The instructions of order 71 should be observed.
