

These Articles of Agreement between
 of the County of Guilford and George L. Anthony
 and County and State of North Carolina
 That the said Anthony hereby agrees
 agree to furnish the primary and
 Green Nursery, or such portion of the same as
 be necessary for the growth of Nursery Plants
 to the said George L. Anthony to be cultivated
 tilled by the said Anthony as a Nursery under the
 Name of West Green Nursery as heretofore and the
 said party of the first part agrees and agrees
 to make all necessary repairs and to furnish
 after July 1st 1867 one half of the Expences
 and the necessary for propagating
 fertility Stock of Trucks & Carriages
 &c. and he furthermore agrees to furnish
 one of said Nursery the Stock persons
 upon the place above named and in the
 Green house at the corner of the Spring
 in N.C. on condition that the said Green
 house and Ornamental and Fruit
 shall not be as depleted as to be
 be them at the present time and further
 the said party of the first part agrees
 with the same and implements
 necessary for such Nursery and to
 and planting and propagating
 and maintenance of said Nursery

in the consideration and on the part
of the said party of the second part, I understand
will, working labor and attending faithfully
to the performance of the duties of a manager,
supervising and handling all the necessary
work, propagating, cultivating and
planting and packing all trees and shrubs
necessary to the successful continuation
of the business, and attending to the Green-
house in a proper manner, and
accounting to the said party of the first
part faithfully for one half the gross re-
ceipts of said business.

And the said party of the second
part hereby covenants, faithfully to per-
form the stipulations herein contained
upon his part and to furnish during
the season necessary for planting during the
Winter and Spring of 1866 of one barrel each
Apple and Apple Seed, Pear Seed and
faithfully to grant perform the duties of a
business manager in the above mentioned
And it is mutually agreed that the business
shall be conducted under the name and firm
of John J. Brown & Co. in the City of Boston,
and that the said party of the second part
in the event of his death, shall be succeeded by
his said heirs and assigns.
