Constitutional Convention of North-Carolina,

Raleigh, June 17th 1868.

My dear wife: I have written to you quite a letter but it is not yet mailed, or completed ~~to~~ so I improve an idle moment in Convention and send you a few lines. I expected to have received a letter from you this morning but seem to have been doomed to disappointment. I have sent you the Daily Standard in which you will find our reports, and get some idea of our proceedings. I am very well satisfied with the Convention and think we shall have an effective and pleasant session. How far we shall go and what we shall do it is impossible to say with any definiteness.

will see by today's report that
we had quite a brisk skirmish
yesterday on the subject of
shutting off legislation. I am very well
satisfied with the stand which self
and Mr Walker are taking in the Con-
vention. We are very comfortably
quartered with a Mr Grossman
and Board at Joseph. Board Light
fuel at \$50 per month. We have
a splendid room and are very com-
fortably situated in every respect. Mr.
Walker is not very well today. A bad
cold only - Hea will not come home
on Saturday of this week nor next.
I am still of the impression that our
session will be a long one. I am very
anxious to hear from you. Unfor-
tunately I brought off all the stamps
and envelopes. I am very sorry
I did not know they were in
my portfolio. We are now
passing upon rules of order. I
have a seat, third in front of the
President on the right hand side, next
to Col Hunter. Our own Golden
you are here. — Albion
