

All vacancies occurring in the offices provided for by this article of this Constitution shall be filled by the appointment of the Governor and the appointees shall hold their places until the next regular election.

31. The officers elected at the first election held under this Constitution, shall hold their offices for the terms prescribed for them respectively next ensuing after the next regular election for members of the General Assembly. But their ~~and~~ terms shall begin shall begin upon the approval of this Constitution by the Congress of the United States.

Divided by lot, into three ^{equal} classes, one of which shall hold office for four years, another for eight years, and the third for twelve years.

~~All the Courts of this State shall~~
The Superior Courts shall be at all times open for the transaction of all business within their jurisdiction, except the trial of juries of fact requiring a jury.

A Solicitor shall be elected for each judicial district by the qualified voters thereof as is prescribed for members of the General Assembly who shall prosecute on behalf of the State in all Criminal actions in the Superior Courts and advise the officers of justice in his district.

In each County there shall be a Sheriff and Coroner ~~and Constable~~ who shall be elected by the qualified voters of the County as is prescribed for members of the General Assembly and shall hold their offices for two years. In each township there shall be a Constable elected in like manner by the voters thereof who shall hold his office for two years.

31 The Justices of the Supreme Courts, the Judges of the Superior Courts, the Justices of the peace the Sheriffs, Coroners and Constables shall be Conservators of the peace within their respective jurisdictions.
