

The B^d Comm^s for Granville Co
Gentlemen,

In reply to the order made by you at the meeting of the B^d on Monday the 29th ult, we have the honor to make the following report:

X In accordance with the agreement of counsel attached to the judgment in case of yourselves vs James I. Moore for Beckham & others, our B^d H. Orfull found upon inspection of the Books in the clerks office, & from vouchers in the hands of J. G. Jones Esq, that there is due & owing to James I. Moore by the county of Granville, a much larger sum than the amount of said judgment, and being satisfied that the amounts so due, were such, as by the terms of said judgment, should be applied in satisfaction thereof, we credited said judgment with the sum of \$1572⁵⁰ which amount fully satisfied the same. The Balance over and above said sum of \$1572⁵⁰ we credited upon the execution in the case of yourselves vs James I. Moore T. L. Rogers & others. We also received \$200⁰⁰ cash for which we credited said judgment as with \$300⁰⁰ (\$200⁰⁰ being the value of \$300⁰⁰ county scrips, which the defendants could have purchased with that sum.)
