My dear wife:

I have been here since last night but have had no chance to write until now about 10 at night and Johnny Buller is now waiting to take it to the office.

There is nothing at all to write. You know the uncertain feeling of a campaign. I sometimes feel encouraged and then discouraged, but I believe on the whole, I have schooled myself to the idea that it will come out all right, let it result as it may. On the whole I am quite satisfied with what I have done and what I am doing. I feel that I am right and look confidently for good and advantage from it. - That is all I think about only to dream of you occasionally and wonder how

the result will affect you. I can
not write you anything about
the campaign because I cannot
write it all - I am thankful that
you are so happy and hope we
may see some more joyful
years if God spurs us - I know
you are thinking of me and
praying for me all the time.
I am glad Lodie is so contented
and hope nothing will ever take
the joy of you all.
