My Dear Wife:

We had our first meeting here yesterday. It was pleasant and quiet with the advantage all on my side - The impression seems to be very general among all parties that I will be elected and it is certainly doing very much for me & Sutton here, is strong for me & I think the prospect very good. Go to Anderson Stone Caswell Co, today & Scales is well and arrived & Fletcher begs and denounces Winston by turns.

Got your Sunday letter just as I left home on yesterday - You will see from my letter that I did not forget your birth day -

I have to ride 20 miles today with a prospect of rain - so I must close
Love to all - God bless you -
