I did not go across last night and expected to do and so have now a few minutes which I take to write you now and say Good Bye my Darling before I start out on my week's work -

It seems to me, that everything is fair I can see no reason for discouragement but yet I do not think my friends fully believe that I will be elected - Bob Douglas says I will be defeated by about \$600 - All are working noble for me however and I think the prospect good so far as I am concerned, what may be behind I know not. I have just got your letter - I am
