My Darling:

I was taken pretty sick on the trip yesterday and had a hard time getting here but am better now. We have a prospect for a good house. About \$150. of tickets sold and I think we will get close to \$100 for our share here. You must not be impatient with me. Now that the weather is better we are doing fairly well. Each week we cleared over \$200 - sent you \$100 and will send \$50 more tomorrow. I thought it better to push in a fortnight here at such rate than to break engagements and come home. Received your two letters here and am glad you are feeling better. I wrote you a long letter yesterday but as it had some rather cross things in it, I made Chas get it out of the mail and tore it up. I shall go on to Santa Fe's and get home about the 21<sup>st</sup> or 22<sup>nd</sup>. Do not worry about me and be as happy as you can for my sake. The weather here is delightful.
