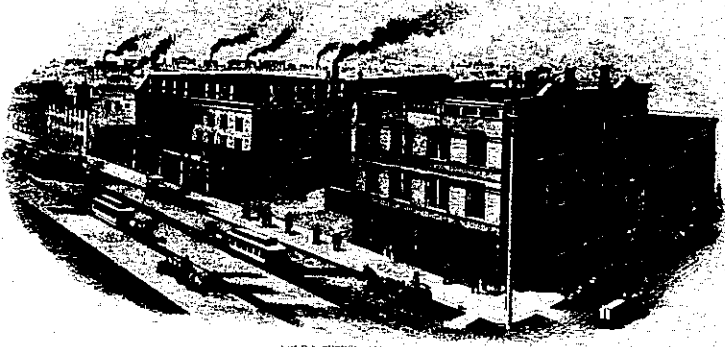

We have your valued favor of recent date.

For our No. 2 Cart (the price is \$47), we quote you a special price of \$32.50; and the Hood extra \$2.25, and seat tray extra \$1, extra Springs \$1, we would include without additional charge. The price given upon the Cart is the same that we quote when shipped in car lots, not including any extras. We omit the Harness thinking perhaps you would do as well in your vicinity. The Harness that we handle we buy in Newark, N. J. and we have none now in stock, but we would order you one shipped from the factory at a cost of about \$16 or \$17 should you further direct us.

We have Carts much less than our No. 2 in price, of the same capacity, that compare favorably with other cheap makes of Carts upon the market, and as low as \$20, but we can hardly advise their purchase.
