My brother tells me he has 2831 impressions on hand of Judge Tougée's plate. They are on heavy paper you remember and of good size, - could be cut down to any size you want.

The price to order the prints on that size and weight of paper would be \$35- per 1000, but he will take \$18 per 1000 if get rid of these on hand.

He has sent me proofs of the plate in its present condition, and I see it is less worn than I thought it would be. It could be

printed from without repairing.
One of the electros needs new
steel-coating, - but of course
you would not use any of the
electros, but print from the
original engraving. The
electros were made in order
to print from all at once
and get out a large edition
rapidly.

Henry also says that if
you take the whole lot, 2831,
he will accept \$57. for them,
and box them for you without
extra charge.

from you again, and I
hope to see you here some
day before very long, - a

welcome guest in my own
