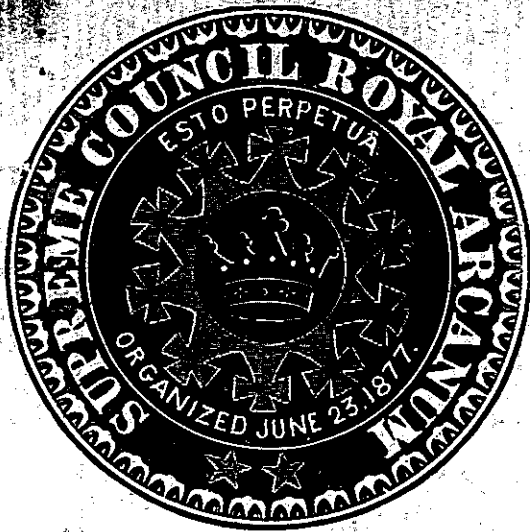

Dear Sir:-

I have received your application for membership from the Secretary of Mayville Council, No. 111, with a certificate attached that you were admitted to membership on Sept. 23, 1887. It appears that your medical examination was made on July 18th, 1887, and that you were not re-examined.

Our Laws prescribe that if sixty days have elapsed from the date of the applicant's medical examination before the Degree is conferred, such medical examination shall be void and a new examination shall be had and approved by the Supervising Examiner before he can receive the Degree.

Inasmuch as this was not complied with in your case, I am compelled to notify you that you cannot be considered as a member of the Order, or entitled to any of its benefits, until the Laws have been fully complied with.
