Mustered into service at Camp Cleveland Ohio, Aug. 2nd/62
 Recd. arms and accoutrements at Columbus Ohio, to report
 to Maj. Gen. Lew. Wallace, Lexington Ky., Aug. 2nd/62 arrived
 at Covington Ky. - Aug. 15th/62 to Lexington by rail & reported
 to Maj. Gen. Nelson. Aug. 30th/62 marched 14 miles
 towards Ky. river in support of U.S. forces at
 Richmond Ky. - Aug. 31st/62 marched back to Lexington
 Sept. 1st/62 picketed on Nicholasville road during day
 and left Lexington in evening under command of Brig.
 Gen. W. R. Ferrill, as rear guard covering retreat
 of U.S. forces under command of Maj. Gen. Gilbrech and
 made forced marches, arriving at Louisville Ky. Sept.
 5th/62. passing through Versailles, Frankfort, Shelbyville
 & Boston. - Sept. 29th/62 assigned to 33rd Brig. 10th Div.
 Army of Ohio.

Oct. 1st/62 marched from Louisville & passing through
 Jeffersonton, Taylorsville, Bloomfield and Chaplin
 arrived at Maxville Oct. 7th/62. - ~~Oct. 8th/62 engaged~~
 Oct. 8th/62, engaged in action at Chaplin Hills
 Perryville Ky. - Ordered first in reserve and
 afterwards ordered forward to support Ooms
 Battery, and by order of Gen. Ferrill took position
 on extreme left of the line of U.S. forces ordered to
 fall back and were accompanied by Gen. Ferrill
 and formed 3 lines in retreat & took up position
 in support of 1st Ky. Battery and so remained
 till 3 A.M. Oct. 9th/62.
