**D**IRECTIONS for Dr. Bush's Hemistatic Pills:—In excessive Hemorrhage from the Lungs; take one pill every hour in a little water, and the same for bleeding of the Nose, Bowels, Bladder or in case of Flooding and Flowing, in which cases an injection should be made of one pill dissolved in a little warm water; When the bleeding has stopped, then double the period of time before taking each pill thereafter.

For Bloody Flux, Dysentery, Urine, Piles, or exusion of blood from wounds, and spitting of blood; take one pill every two or three hours until the bleeding entirely ceases. Keep quiet. For profuse perspiration, sweating of blood, involuntary discharges of urine, take one pill at night and sponge the skin all over with equal parts of alcohol and cool water, with some salt in the wash, rise early in the morning and take one of Dr. Bush's Malarial pills, exercise moderately, avoid hot drinks, and retire at a regular hour and con-

tinue this course until cured. In extreme cases where something must be quickly done a telegraph money order will ensure a box of these pills by the next mail.

For childrens' use, dissolve one pill and one tablespoon of sugar in one ounce of water, and take a teaspoonful to every 3 years of age.

**D**IRECTIONS for Dr. Salisbury's Celebrated Eye Salve:—Wash and cleans the eye with some warm soft water in the morning, and at night apply this salve in and around the eye, or oftener in bad cases of scrofulus or inflamed sore eyes, granulated eye-lids and films on the eye ball. It destroys the ulceration, inflammation, and cools the eye, prevents weeping of the eyes and strengthens the sight.

**D**IRECTIONS for Dr. Bush's Dissolvent:—For enlarged joints, glands or spleen, ague cake, pleurisy, pneumonia, sciatic rheumatism, spinal complaint and paralysis, sponge the affected parts with one teaspoon each of salt and mustard, and  $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon of saltpetre in one teacup of vinegar and two cups of boiling water; rub well and wipe dry, and rub in the Dissolvent with the fingers sparingly so that it will not produce a blister, unless desired in some cases.

For corns, bunions, calous, wens, goiter, rue neck, lumbar abscess, ovarian tumors, enlargement of the prostate gland, strains, sprains and internal injuries, also for curb splint, spavin, sweeney, and ringbone of horses, and to restore the hair of man or beast to its natural growth and color, sponge the parts with one teaspoon each of salt, mustard and sal soda, and a little saltpetre in a pint of hot water, rub well and wipe dry, and work the Dissolvent into the flesh with the fingers. Continue daily until cured.
