

Pine Bluff Ark. Feb 4th 1891
My dear Judge -
Your letter of Jan 27/89 I
saw days ago to hand
and contents noted - and
must say in return that it seems to
me that you are one man by yourself
so far as humanitarian rights are concerned.
Do you know that it appears to me not
so well skilled as yourself that not
the south but the North also has gone
Crazy on the subject of Money Making
and that all attempts in legislation politics
and religion at patriotism is dead -
You cannot doubtless number in the
history of your life when such a desperate
effort was ever made by members of any
law making body to trade and traffic in
human rights as by our present Senators
and as has been said by some person
that truly these are desperate days

and that the reason the Southern
 Senators and Law Makers are
