Fife Assaulted.

BY JUDGE SCHENCK'S
THREE SONS.

Greensboro Shaken From
Centre to Circumfer-
ence and her People
Indignant.

"ALL FOR JESUS! BLESS
GOD!"

Is What the Evangelist Exclaimed
During the Affair.

AN INDIGNATION MEETING HELD, IN
WHICH JUDGE SCHENCK IS UN-
DERLY DENOUNCED.

GREENSBORO, N. C., June 27.

Greensboro never saw nor heard of such a day of excitement as reigns here today.

Business is almost suspended for a while, and the whole city is highly indignant.

WHY THE EXCITEMENT?

Several nights ago Judge David Schenck gave a moonlight party at the Guilford Battle Ground in which Evangelist Fife, through a riotous process lasted all night.

Mr. Fife, in his meetings here denounced it as a disgrace to the soldiers who died on the field, as a desecration of sacred soil. He also reflected on the name of Judge Schenck and family and declared that no true Christians would engage in such.

On yesterday afternoon Judge Schenck and his three sons called at the room of Mr. Fife, in the McCadoo House, and demanded an apology. Mr. Fife replied: "Look a-here, you have struck the wrong fellow."

They then left without violence, but were present at the night meeting, when the matter was casually referred to by Mr. Fife.

At the close of the meeting it was whispered that Mr. Fife would be attacked, whereupon Mr. Fife said: "Friends, hold on a minute; I understand that I will be attacked." Many voices replied, "They will have to attack us too"—and Mr. Bilhorn added, "and Jesus too."

A hundred men escorted Mr. Fife to his room and as soon as they left him the three young Schencks came up and attacked Mr. Fife in the presence of his wife and threatened to kill him. Mrs. Fife exclaimed: "You are not going to assault a man of God in the presence of ladies." They replied "No not in the presence of ladies."

Mr. Fife then approached the buggy in which Judge Schenck was sitting, offering him his hand to which the Judge responded: "I won't shake hands with any such damn scoundrel!" Mr. Fife was then struck by Dr. Schenck with a loaded cane and staggered. Dr. Schenck then fired a pistol.

Mr. Fife was then taken to a drug store for treatment and on returning on the arm of Mr. McCadoo exclaimed: "All for Jesus, Bless God!"

At this time an indignation meeting is being held, and resolutions have been presented condemning Judge Schenck and upholding Mr. Fife. Judge Schenck is now speaking to defend himself.

The feeling is almost wholly with Mr. Fife, and Judge Schenck may be asked to resign the position as President of the Battle Ground Association.
