the measure which is not
correct in every respects.
The measure is put thus;
 $5\frac{1}{2}$ length which would make your measure
short which is likely true. $8\frac{1}{2}$ ball
 $9\frac{1}{2}$ instep this is where the trouble
to canvas, I never knew 1 inch
different in toe and instep.
I inclose measure strap and
blank with instructions
which will enable you to take
or which is much better to have
some one to use the strap
while you sat with right leg
crossed over left knee letting
the foot hang easy beginning
at the ball over the inside and
out side; airt. Take 2-3-4 & 5 times
in order and set them down so
of the right foot. I will understand
take measure over woolen sock

or as heavy as you please. Draw
the strap moderately tight all
over the foot and be careful
to draw the strap with or
opposable to the lines and draw
and bend figures just as taken.
State if there is any tenderness or
corns if so locate them. If you take the
6 measure 6 inches up the ankle
over draw I will clinch the buttons.
I think from drawing sent me
that wide toes would suit best.
State when you expect to start
west. I will likely get the shoes
to you about the first of the
month. If you have any preference
in the leather or any
thing else state it though I
will put in something that looks
and wears most fully yours
to Smith.

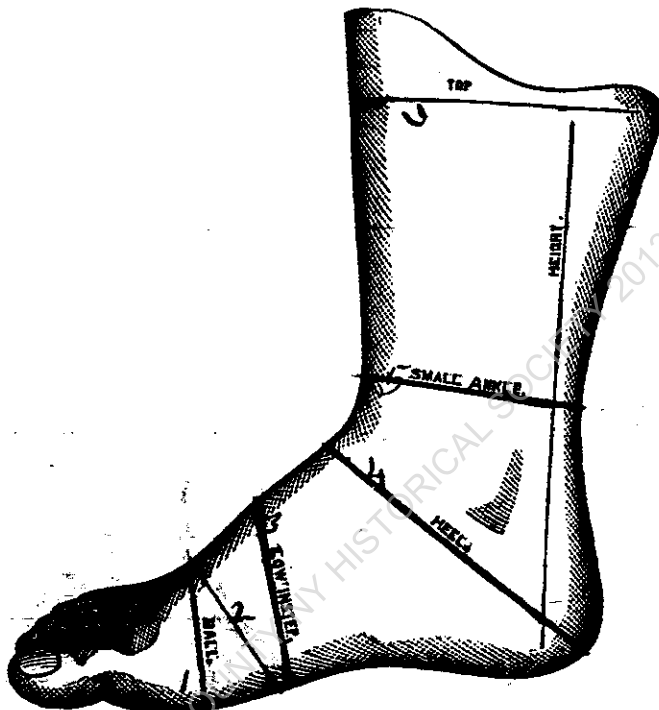
