The uppers are made throughout
and are of the tightest of
the new fine goods that names
this heavy. It is almost certain
that if they fit as they should
you will be pleased with
the goods and make. I made
the ramps of Kangaroo calf
and the tops of German Seal. The
shoe will certainly last for steady
use and care three years. Keep them

alive and soft with pure
ketofoot oil made by your
butchers then the blaking
will not eat out the live
texture. I was going to make
the express of English Seal or
Candovan though when I
came to think of you being
from home so long they
both are apt to get hard
sooner. I think they will keep
your feet comfortable without
over shoes if so they will hold
their own much longer. I
fastened the buttons because I
am sure they are alright as
both measures agreed in that
region.
