For value received, we, and each of us, Albion W. Tourgee, Emma K. Tourgee, and Aimee Tourgee, parties of the first part, acknowledge ourselves held and firmly bound to Elsie A. Burnett the party of the second part, in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars Signed with our hands, sealed with our seals, this 21st day of October, A.D. 1895.

The conditions of this obligation are, that whereas, heretofore, to wit on the 20th day of August A.D. 1895, the said party of the second part did give, grant and bestow upon the above-named Albion W. Tourgee, one of the parties of the first part, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, upon the sole condition that he shall pay and remit to her, semi-annually, upon the 20th day of February and the 20th day of August in each year during the lifetime of the said Elsie A. Burnett, the sum of Sixty Dollars. (\$60 amounting to One Hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.) in each year.

Now, therefore, if the said Albion W. Tourgee, his heirs, successors or either of the above-named co-obligors with him, shall well and truly perform his said obligations, and, on each of the dates named or within 30 days thereafter, shall pay to the said Elsie A. Burnett the just and full sum of Sixty Dollars in each and every year, during the lifetime of the said Elsie A. Burnett the above written obligation shall be null and void; otherwise the same shall continue in full force and effect. The purpose of said obligation being understood to be to provide for the payment of an annuity equal to the interest of the said sum of Two Thousand Dollars at six percent during the lifetime of the said Elsie A. Burnett, and not to bind the parties of the first part to any re-payment of the sum bestowed, either to her or her heirs, the said principal being intended as a gift to the said Albion W. Tourgee, and not a loan.
