tion of the sum on One Dollar to me in hand paid, and for ^{other} good
and valuable considerations, I, Elsie A. Burnett, of Winnebago, in
the State of Illinois, do hereby give, grant, assign and set over
to Emma K. Tourgee of Mayville, in the county of Chautauque,
state of New York, her heirs and assigns, all my right
interest in and to the estate of my brother, Stephen M. Paddock,
late of the county of Tompkins in the state of New York, lately
deceased, hereby authorizing and empowering her, the said Emma
K. Tourgee, in my name and stead to sue for, collect, take, hold,
transmit and assign any money or property that may issue to me
by bequest or inheritance from the estate of my said brother,
Stephen M. Paddock, whether by specific devise, as residuary leg-
atee, or as one of the heirs of the said Stephen M. Paddock, in
the same manner and with as full and complete right of posses-
sion and enjoyment, as I myself, have or may become entitled to,
whether said right be present and actual or future and contin-
gent, this assignment being full and absolute and without con-
dition or restriction, conveying any and all interest which I
have or may have in said estate whether devised by devise or
inheritance to the said Emma K. Tourgee for the proper enjoy-
ment and behoof of herself, her heirs and assigns forever.
