Emma;

I am again in
camp and you do not know how
good it seems. We have not yet
got our quarters up and are now
bunking in with the men and
it is almost like recollecting the
life of a year ago and more.
We have a splendid company
and I have not enjoyed myself
so well two days in a year.
We have just as good a lot of officers
~~and~~ ~~as~~ ~~we~~ ~~could~~ ~~ask~~ ~~for~~ ~~in~~
the regiment. The camp is a
bout $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Superior
Street and is in a very pleas-
ant location. We have not
yet drilled much but will

be at it in earnest, I think
we shall soon have the very
best regiment that has ever
gone from this part of the
Country. I received a telegram
from Lizzie, the day we left
Ashtabula, saying that you
were at West field, on your
way home as I inferred
from your letter, after words re-
ceived, I was sorry to send a
reply stating my destination &
that I could not come.

I will try and see you soon
if I can get a furlough.

I have just got my sword
back, & am begining to feel natu-
ral and military again. I dont
know when I can come down
but think I can get a chance be-
fore we leave here.

I want to write you
great deal more but am

not time now.

Do not have
any fears about me for I
am all right and shall be
till I am —
