Sir:

I respectfully tender my resignation as first Lieutenant of Co. "G" 103<sup>rd</sup> Regt. U. S. Inf. - Not that I have any desire to leave the service, - a service with which I have been connected since the breaking out of the war (except while disabled by wounds), - but for the following reasons; - I am not in the least to be respected; that our political affairs are influenced by principles, and our republications threatened, I cannot longer serve in this position with that degree of pride which our Country and her cause demands, with honor to myself. I therefore respectfully ask the acceptance of this resignation.
