Dear Mother

I am in great tribulation. I have been quite shut off since Oct 21st - from my old affliction of the back, brought on again and induced by an unlucky fall. Do not be alarmed. I am able to walk short distances with a cane and may recover my health. On the other hand I may be lame in a week or two. I have a physician who has seen but says I must have a rest of the same kind as I do now. A hospital has been recommended. I shall probably have to resign or stay here and they say there is little chance of my getting better here. I may try it. I may be sent back to Nashville for treatment. I feel sure you may come to me - not otherwise. You may hear from me again soon. Do not be alarmed if you don't. Thanks very many for letters.
