

Constitutional Convention of North-Carolina,

Raleigh, Feb'y 10<sup>th</sup> 1868.

My Dear Wife: Your letter of Saturday was received this morning. I am busy now and can only write you a few words. I am very sorry for you and for the folks at home, but I don't know that it can be amended, farther than the money you have sent them. Do not be troubled. I will send some money as soon as possible. Do not agitate yourself. Allah il Allah. "Though I die, yet will I trust in Him." You know God has never yet forsaken us, and I hope and believe he never will. I cannot see how His hand will work out the divine wisdom and beauty of His law, but I cannot but trust in Him.
