by the Chair

Mr Rodman introduced
the following resolution, ^{as amended by Mr Hood} which
on motion was adopted

Resolved That the delegate
from Guilford arrested by
order of the President of
this Convention be dischar-
ged from arrest, and that
the Convention will proceed
to the business before it

Mr Hood amended by adding, "Unlawfully," after Guilford
