Dear Mrs. Tourgee:-

I meant to have written some days before your second letter came along. In the first place, I should have returned the verses you sent me at once because The Sunday Magazine is out of the market entirely for anything in the way of rime or verse and has been for a long time. But what I wanted most to tell you was that I think a very good way to dispose of the story I returned to you would be to place it with some literary agent here in New York City. There are at least two very active ones- Mr. Seth Westcott Moyle, of Moyle, Hanshaw & Co., 1 Madison Avenue, N. Y. and Paul R. Reynolds, 70 Fifth Avenue, N. Y. I think that either one of them would be able to place such a story within a very short space of time. Should you send it to either of them, I think you ought to put a price upon it, or, at least, give them some indication of the compensation you expect for it, and to pay no membership or reading fee- nothing save only the usual literary agents commission. I think you would get quite as good a price for it in this way as in any other.

You ask about "The Green Bag." It is still published, I believe, at 31 State Street, Boston, but I am inclined to think that either of the New York literary agents would give you a better price
