Dear Madam:

Your favor of the 17th duly received in reply to our letter of the 15th inst. The statement you make therein we have no right to challenge or dispute, at the same time the statements made on the 15th were done in good faith, and in every instance what we received would bear us out in the same, with the exception of your signature which you state was written by your daughter. That part of it under the circumstances was in error when we stated that the contract had been signed by you, but the fact that it was signed Mrs. E. K. Tourgee, we naturally inferred that you were the party who had signed the order. We notice that you decline to accept our draft so we presume that the same will be returned in due course to us through our bankers.

This we are sorry to hear as we thought you might after our explanation be willing to live up to the contract which we had acted upon. We know that the stock was in good condition when sent from here at the same time the contract under which your order was taken entitles you to have anything that might fail the first season replaced, subject to the account having been duly settled and we are at all times prepared to live up to that part with customers and replace anything that fails the first season on their notifying us on or before the 1st of Aug. following the delivery of the stock and we are quite prepared to act in the same way toward you regarding anything that may have failed, although it is evident that the failures are due largely to the fact that the stock was not planted out when delivered.

Of course you are right when you state that the goods were not delivered when you wanted them, or they would have been attended to when they were delivered, but we delivered the goods at the time your order called for, so that we are not responsible for this error. We are writing our salesagent regarding this order to day, and we will see what he has to say for himself under the circumstances.

In the mean time we leave this matter in your hands and if you see fit to settle the account we are quite prepared to make good anything that has failed and deliver same at your residence in Fall '07
