We are in receipt of your card of recent date, and note what you say regarding the Uncle Joe Strawberries. Judging the quality of the Uncle Joe Strawberries, there should be taken into consideration that one variety is not adapted to all kinds of soils and conditions. We have received a number of very complimentary letters regarding the quality of this berry, but it is very evident that it is not adapted to your soil. We would suggest that you try two varieties next time, and if satisfactory we will forward you, twelve each of what we consider two of the leading varieties, namely, Dubach and William Belt, next Fall. These are both extra fine quality, good size and splendid yield.
