There are several mistakes in this bill.

In the first place, I paid for the water meters several months ago, viz by check dated July 30th, mailed the same day--and have the receipt of the Village Treasurer for the same, dated August 9th.

There is evidently something wrong in the numbering of the meters.-- Apartment No. 1, (that occupied by F. A. Nelson) is charged with only 6337 gallons of water, when their water closet ran full force for 10 hours one day last summer after the meters were put in, Mrs Nelson having gone to Jamestown and taken the key of the Apartment with her, and no one could get in to turn the water off. This flooded the garden by the overflow of the cess pool. All this is charged to Apartment No. 3, occupied by Mrs Leland who is extremely economical in the use of water and could not possibly have used this amount charged to her Apartment.

Apartments No. 4, (F. M. Waite's) and No. 2, my own, are about normal.

Mr Erickson put in the Meters and numbered them. I will advise him of his evident error in the numbering, have him correct the same, and report

When these mistakes are rectified, kindly send the bills to the individuals occupying the different Apartments, as when the meters were put in, that arrangement was made. Of course, the Village has the right to turn off the water from any Apartment when the rates for that Apartment are not paid--and the owner is responsible for it.
