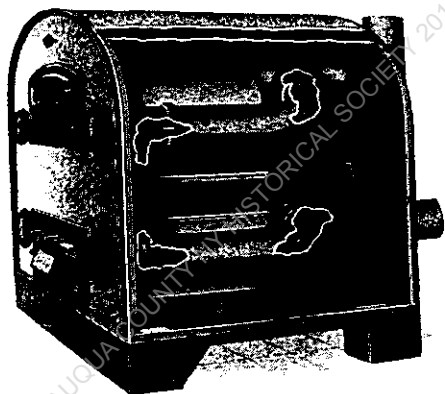

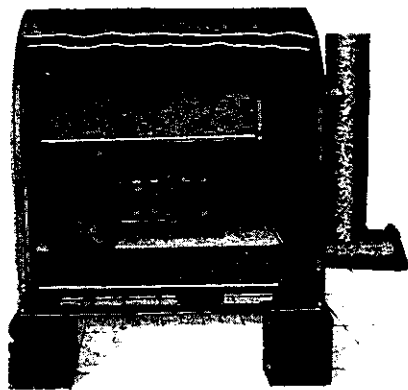

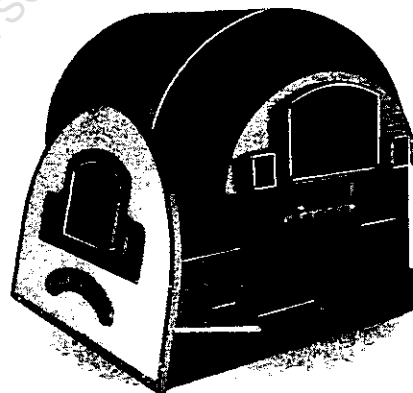
Flue Construction and Fuel Economy.

Furnaces for Shallow Cellars.

The latest type of BRIEN HEATER, (40 to 46 inches tall) is nearly two feet less to the top of the casing than the lowest of the upright type which is an important consideration in heating residences having shallow cellars.



Its Simplicity for Cleaning or Repairing Appeals.

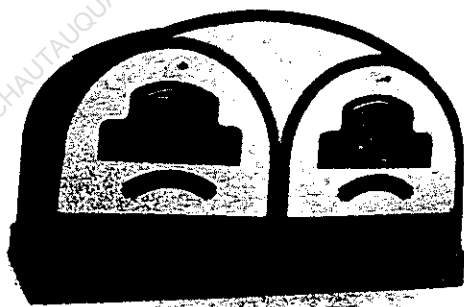
Can you not clearly see from the above cut that the radiating parts can all be removed for inspection or repairs without disturbing the casings and heater pipes.

To the Farmer

Whose wood pile is equivalent to the city residents' bin of coal, Brien Heaters are especially adapted, as four foot wood cut in half, will fit the rectangular fire pot, and a charcoal fire will last for hours as in old fashioned wood stoves. The doors are large and will admit waste chunks.

Comparison.
