You will readily see, however, we must have the information before we know whether the property would be of any value to us or not and so we are looking over the same intelligently.

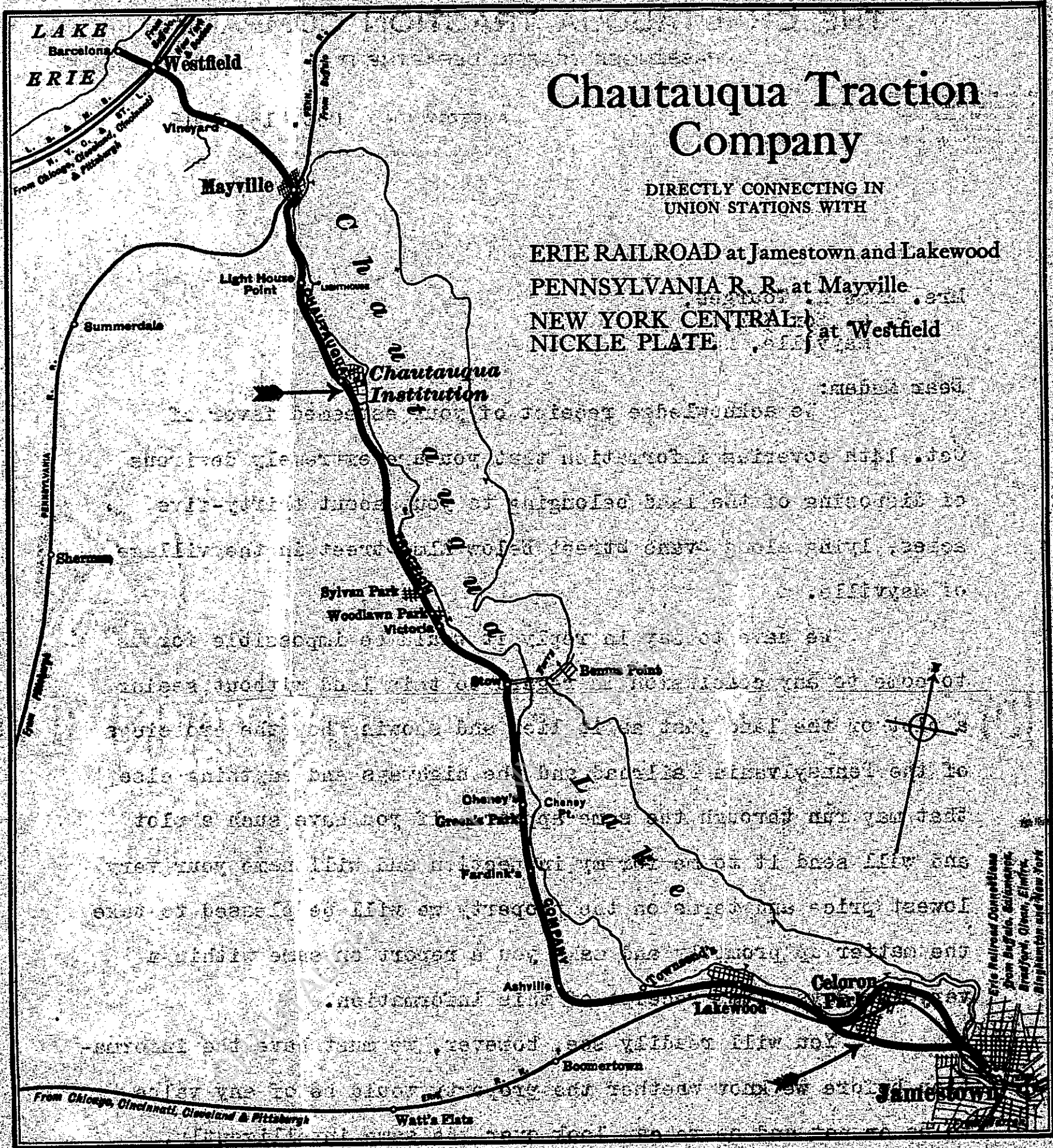
