The scope and object of MEN AND WOMEN OF THE TIME are so clearly indicated on its title-page that it is scarcely necessary to explain them at any length. The work was originally undertaken to fill a place, till then unoccupied by any of the numerous books of reference which the industry and enterprise of the age have provided for almost every class of the community, by furnishing memoirs of eminent living persons of both sexes, in all parts of the civilized world.

Four years have elapsed since the appearance of the Twelfth Edition, and during that period three hundred and seventy individuals who were noticed in its columns have been removed by death. Their places are occupied, in the present Edition, by memoirs of seven hundred and forty-four persons whose names during the same period have come prominently before the public. The total number of sketches comprised in this new volume is two thousand four hundred and fifty.

In its essential features the work remains unchanged from preceding issues, but the title has been altered from "Men of the Time" to "Men and Women of the Time," the size of the pages has been considerably increased and a number of internal improvements have been made. Before putting the sketches into type they were submitted, wherever it was practicable, to their subjects for revision, and thus they may be considered, to a large extent, autobiographical. The latest information was utilized up to the time of going to press, in order to bring the work down to the most recent date possible.

A greater space has been devoted in this Edition than in any previous one to American memoirs, which, as heretofore, have been prepared by an American biographer. In this respect the Thirteenth Edition will be found, it is hoped, not less valuable than its predecessors.
