

Ambrose Cherry Mason

Born in Wetherfield Sp. Insubull & Ohio  
Nov 10<sup>th</sup> 1840. Died near Atlanta Ga Aug 27. 1864.  
Capt Mason first enlisted in 1861 in C. B.  
19<sup>th</sup> Regt O. S. I. in three months service  
and served until mustered out of the Regt.  
One week later he re-enlisted in the  
42<sup>nd</sup> O. S. I. and was made Orderly Sergeant  
of Co. A. and served with that Regiment  
until June 1862 when he received a  
recruiting commission for the 105<sup>th</sup> O. S. I.  
~~the 105<sup>th</sup> O. S. I.~~ On Aug 22. 1863  
he was mustered in as First Lieut of  
Co. C. promoted to Captain March 14 1863.  
and remained in command of his Company until  
his death except for a short time was detached  
as Adjut. Officer in Staff of Gen. Rosecrans.  
He died on the eve of the battle of Jonesboro. was  
buried by his Company in the garden of a Mrs  
Patterson near Atlanta but his body was

afterward removed and reinterred in the  
National Cemetery at Chattanooga  
Capt Mason was a genial companion  
a brave officer and a conscientious soldier  
and his death regretted by all his comrades.
