

1- The papers and books demanded by Rufus and Wm. A. Bobbitt, are all papers in relation to the manufacture of tobacco in Factory No. 4 of the Fourth Collection District and are essential as evidence in various criminal prosecutions already instituted and about to be instituted to protect the United States from fraudulent evasions of the Revenue laws. They are comprised under heads-

- 1- Bills of tobacco bought for manufacture - and bills of leading showing the same to have been received.
- 2- Letters from parties to whom tobacco had been sold - express receipts - and bills of tobacco sold.
- 3- Bills of machinery purchased and located and used in the factory -
- 4- Receipts and acknowledgements of Postal orders and Express parcels.
- 5- A book containing an account of the labor performed in said factory its character and amount and therefore directly pertinent to the question of the legality of its operation, extending to show the amount of its production.
