Nonwood's Rule of Practice - for the destruction of the Court.

The State may rest when it sums pleases and keep doing so, as long as it pleases and introduce its main testimony after the defence has closed. This is a rule of Practice unknown to the Court but known to Bar.

Charge - \$1000 Cost, used

If you are satisfied that McCauley ^{used} exercised violence against the defendant and the defendant used violence only to resist the force employed by McCauley then you will find a verdict of not guilty.

If you are satisfied that the defendant offered and used violence towards the witness McCauley, without the witness having offered or used violence towards the defendant you will find a verdict of guilty.
