I That Benj<sup>n</sup> Bro. ~~Shire~~ being one of said County, in his life time made and published his last will and testament but appointed no Executor thereto

II That on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1863 in said County said Benj<sup>n</sup> Bro. ~~Shire~~ died -

III That at August Term 1863 of this Court of Pleas & quarter sessions of Randolph County, Letters of Administration with the will annexed on his estate were duly issued to the Plaintiff by said Court -

IV That on the 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1863 the Plaintiff proceeded to sell the property of said deceased

V That one Isiah Prag bid off and purchased of said property to the

amount of three hundred & sixty  
 nine dollars & thirty six cents for which  
 the said Bag and the defendant executed  
 & delivered to the plaintiffs above under  
 their hands & seals of which the following  
 is a copy 369,36 six months after date we  
 promise to pay Mary Brookshire a daughter  
 of Benj Brookshire died the sum of  
 three hundred & sixty nine <sup>36</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars for  
 value received - witness our hands  
 & seals August 26<sup>th</sup> 1863
