That at August Term 1863 of the Court of Pleas & quarter sessions of Randolph County - letters of administration with the will annexed on his estate been duly issued to the Plaintiff by said Court

IV

That on the 26th & 27th day of August 1863 the Plaintiff proceeded to sell the property of said deceased,

V

That the defendant James Page bid off of said property to the amount of six hundred & seven dollars & ten cents

for which the defendants executed and delivered to the Plaintiff a bond under their hands & seals of which the following is a copy #60710 Six months after date we promised to pay Mary Brookshire administratrix with the will annexed of Benj Brookshire dec'd Six hundred & seven dollars & ten cents for value received witness our hands and seals this 27th of August 1863
