My clients after many exertions are unable to give the security required to obtain the order of Restraint. I have prepared Affidavits & certificates and according to my view, although a bond is required before an Injunctio Thon issue, I see no such provision for an Order of Restraint. If the order which is asked for can be made it will meet the justice of the case, as the plaintiffs and those holding under them are persons of wealth and influence, and those who are otherwise disposed to aid my clients, are afraid of giving offence. If you cannot ^{grant} the order asked for, a deposit of \$100.00 might possibly be made.
