Your honor will please to give me your opinion in regard to the legality of witnesses receiving one dollar per day and six cents mileage in a Magistrates Court. I have not been able to find in any statute, any but the one Compensation to witnesses, I wish to know if that applies to a Magistrate Court as well as a Superior Court, as it appears in the Code of Procedure that the Compensation to jurors in a Magistrates Court is twenty five cents each, ^{and} as some of the Magistrates of the County are of different opinion in regard to the fees of witnesses and jurors you will please to give me some instructions in regard to the matter.

I would also like to have your opinion in regard to the duty of the Township Clerk in a Magistrates Court, and how he is to be compensated, as the Code of Procedure is not explicit in his case and does not lay down a schedule of fees, more than his per diem.
