My dear Sir

Some time ago the
clerk of this County mailed
to you at Essex a
proffer in the case of M^r Davis
vs M^r Davis, Petition for Partition
of real estate. We have heard
nothing from them since.

The papers were sent to you for
your signature as a matter
of course. Please forward
the papers at once or it will
be too late for the Partition to be
made this Fall.

Judge. I believe the Commissioners
have the power and it is made their
duty to require all the officers to
renew their bonds annually.
If this is so we may get rid of him
in this way. If not why then we must
look to. Before acting however I want
you to inspect for yourself.

power to remove him. Don't
fill the place until you let Mr.
know. I think the appointment
of John A. Thompson would give
as much satisfaction in the County
as any other man. He is moving
