 with one Abram Coltrane under their hands
 and seals to pay to the said Abram Coltrane the
 sum of two hundred & fifty dollars
 that they have ~~not~~ paid the same that on the 21st day
 of April 1869 in Randolph County the said Abram
 Coltrane died intestate
 that on the 21st day of May 1869 letters of administration
 upon the estate said Abram Coltrane
 was duly issued by the Probate Judge
 of the County of Randolph to the plaintiff by which
 he was appointed administrator of all the goods
 and ~~debts~~ credits belonging to the said Abram
 Coltrane at the time of death
 wherefore the plaintiff demands judgement for the
 sum of two hundred and fifty dollars with interest
 from the 6th day of February 1861 - and for his
 costs for this action
