Parties came to my house about
Oct 30th a week after the meeting at
Mt. Pleasant. Geo. Wilson was one of the
parties. Have known him from a small
boy. Monroe Thompson, have known
him some 10 or 15 years. Also Thompson
know him by 20 yrs. I know
of his face - Geo. Gregg - have known
him since the war. Saw his
face about month & a half
Geo. A. Coble - had a little patch
of whisker on his chin. Had seen
him that morning - saw Michael
Eubank. His beard was as it is
now. Have known him from
boyhood - there was one I did not
know - name of him bodily -
He was about the
size of Wm. Coble - They took me out
and whipped me - Think it was about
10 or 11

Gregg had beard on his chin that night -
The 9th man, if a man, was a small man
I thought him a boy from his size and
build. Wilson & Gus Thompson took
me out of bed. They held me and some
others whipped me. Nobody told me to do
this - Sworn against them last Wednesday
day was a week - I waited because I
wanted to get some more information
I made mighty little talk about
this.

Eliza Shoffner - Wife of Andy Shoffner
live in this county, 1 Mile from Hutson
mill - on the Greensboro Road - Live
on Mr Brown's land - 1/4 mile from
her home. Con - Andy lives near one
about 6 weeks since, on Saturday night
between 72 & day - Myself, husband and
Sister Child Rely was present - They came
to the house, burst open the door, struck
a light. They went around the house and came
to the bed and dragged my husband out, feet
forward and dragged him out. One took
me out one side and one on the other &
led me out, whipped my husband and then
two held up my clothes and whipped me
They had on caps like, black trimmed
with white and red. They had eye-holes
and the cloth came around under the
chin, and kept the mouth bare - They
were within a very ~~short~~ few inches of
me - witness illustrated showing about
15 inches from my face - I was seized
Geo W, Gregg, Michael Ellis & Austin
Thompson. There were six of them but three

all I knew - knew Gregg by his
mouth - saw Enless by his mouth
was seized with Enless - was a slave of Mr
Shopper & was seized in the rear of the
Mr Gregg says been in the neighborhood four or
five years - Mr Enless & Mrs Gregg took me
out of bed - Another man stood at the
foot of the bed with a match - I could
see all the faces except above the eyes -
Mr Thompson did the talking. Had known
him a long time - Had no doubt as
to this identification - After that they went
to Dave Ingle & said they "give those
knippers down the country" - Dave said
"All right" - Then they went over to Mrs
Kennis - broke the door down and
I heard Mrs talking to them. It is
but a short distance - Bill Williams
whipped my feet I knew him by his voice
He was whispering while he whipped Andy -
I thought I had mentioned him before -
Three of them struck their lights when they
came in - I knew his face when I
saw him in the house -

It was on Saturday night - It was a
week or two after the meeting at Jinn -
I remember it was after the meeting because
Mike Enless professed religion then -
Saw him and knew him by his mouth and
eyes - They struck matches 3 or 4 times - looked
whispered - Thompson talked loud - knew
Gregg also by his mouth - I did not speak of
Wilson at first as I was somewhat frightened
There was seven there - I knew but four of them -

I knew four of them - Andy knew the rest
I saw a portion of the face - upper lip
chin & part of each side -

The others - two of them were small-
sized men or boys - He got over the fence be-
fore the rest and said "lets go" - Andy whipped me

I never told any one that they had struck
me across the back - never showed
much "swipe" to any one -

to any organization for service

night Oct 30 - the day - Big
Meeting on Sunday following -
Was at home that night - How-
ells & Mike Ennis - He went to
bed before he did - He went to bed
and was there about 2 o'clock
clock struck just as I got into bed

Remember that clock struck 12
when I was up some two or 3 o'clock
before - Do not know whether there was a
moon when Ennis went to bed.

There was no moon at 2 o'clock, it was
a clear night -

Went out on North side of house -
The moon was not shining that I saw
The house did cast a shadow
I remember that distinctly - It
was a sort of a shadow -

From J. Foy's man - David heard of

the affair - on Monday following Nov. 1st
was first on that night at Mr
Mr Coble's - Went there with Cable to Thomp-
son's - Monroe Thompson's - Went -
Thompson lives 1/2 mile from Coble's - Played
cards there until after 11 o'clock - Myself
& Cable went out together & Foy
called to us & said he was coming - He went
on with Cable & Coble to Ennis's house -
Left Thompson's out for from midnight -
He slept with me & I left him
