My dear wife:

After a very fatiguing trip from Rainsville we arrived here about 8 1/2 P.M. - The Grand jury was sworn and charged and we are ready for business tomorrow. I think the term will be a very short one and I shall try and be at home on Sat. perhaps on Friday. You may tell William that I may send for him to come over after me. There is some land over this way which I want him to see before he buys elsewhere - If I conclude to do so I will write again so that he can get Billy & Dave on the creek and come down on Thursday, or so - I may conclude to go back and get some up to Rainsville at another time - I have not had any time to look about here yet - I was very tired and had a terrible headache. Slept only from 4 1/2 until 6 1/2 this morn. There is a heap of business here but they are quick just now - I will write more to you in the morning.

Tuesday a.m. — I think we
shall get through here by about
Wednesday or Thursday night. If
you are sick before that time push
Telegraph to J. M. Harris, Rindville to send
over for me. I will write again tonight.
