

James M. Stockard - Additional Statement.

Am twenty one years old. Got the bed cords out of Henry Holt's house. I know James Bradshaw staid. I think James Mike Thompson staid because he seemed to be one of the ones guarding Outlaw. He started with him as a guard from Holt's and I think he staid with him.

Jesse Thompson was with two or three one of whom was on a white horse. Jesse Thompson son of Big Sam Thompson, held the horses ^{a party of} those who went forward to the tree to hang Outlaw. The number was from three to five that were assisting in the hanging. There were more around there dismounted.

No one left the crowd from the time they took Outlaw until they reached the Court House where he was hung, that I know of.
